We regret to announce that repairs on the cranes of the PFL Matai are still in progress and she is now expected to depart Lautoka on the afternoon of 23-Feb. She is expected to arrive in Apia on the evening of 26-Feb and will continue with her normal rotation to Tauranga and then omit Australian Ports to recover her schedule on Voy 2
