NZPAC Schedule Update – Fiji Congestion

Dear Valued Customer,

Please be advised that due to ongoing berth congestion in Fiji and out-of-service Port Mobile Harbour cranes resulting in vessel delays, we have made changes to our schedule to mitigate this cargo disruption.

Capitaine Tupaia 0537S will now also omit Suva along with Apia on this voyage, instead only calling Lautoka before proceeding to Tauranga to meet her scheduled window. Any urgent Suva exports to New Zealand currently booked on this voyage will be transferred to the Neptune Matua 0538 with remaining non urgent bookings transferred to the Capitaine Tasman 0539. She will now berth in Lautoka after the PFL Matai 0537.

PFL Matai 0537N will now call Apia after departing Lautoka to deliver all Apia imports onboard. She will then depart from the NZPAC Service.

Neptune Matua 0538 will berth in Suva on the 29th October and then proceed with her planned rotation of Suva, Lautoka, Apia, Pago Pago and Tauranga.
