**Increased Capacity for peak season – NZ to Samoa’s & Tonga**

Dear Valued Customers,

In order for Pacific Forum Line to continue to provide an optimum service between New Zealand and Apia, Nuku’alofa & Pago Pago, we will be deploying additional tonnage for the 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> quarters of this year, to support the Southern Lily on her fortnightly frequency in this trade.

In July, the Southern Trader V1426 will call Nuku’alofa & from August to December, Capitaine Dampier will be making schedule calls into Nuku’alofa en route for Fiji.

With this in mind, we will also plan to reverse the rotation of the Southern Lily to call Apia & Pago Pago before Nuku’alofa, during the Tongan squash season around October, to provide a premium service between Tonga and New Zealand for this product.
