



**Re: Low Sulphur Fuel (LSFO) Update**

**1<sup>st</sup> June 2020**

Dear Valued Customers,

Pacific Forum Line (PFL) wishes to advise that following our Q220 monitoring of Low Sulphur Fuel Oil (LSFO) which covers the period 26<sup>th</sup> February to 25<sup>th</sup> May 2020, that with effective from 1<sup>st</sup> July 2020 (\*) the LSFO will not be applied within our Australia, New Zealand, Fiji (including Interisland) to and from Pacific Islands trade lanes.

First applicable vessels as follows;

- From Australia – Kokopo Chief v25 eta Melbourne 2<sup>nd</sup> July
- From Suva – Southern Moana v24 eta Lautoka 7<sup>th</sup> July
- From New Zealand
  - Capitaine Tasman v32 eta Tauranga 3<sup>rd</sup> July
  - Southern Trader v477 eta Auckland 12<sup>th</sup> July

(\*) Cook Islands – No change to that applied within the trade today.
