Southern Trader V492 is delayed in her voyage back to New Zealand due to poor weather conditions. She is expected to berth Auckland after the Capitaine Magellan on the 07th of June pm. She will be loading cargo for Nuku'alofa with an eta Monday 14th of June and cargo delivery to Papeete around the 18th of June.

Southern Moana V34 is expected to work in Auckland on the 15th of June. She will be loading cargo for Apia and Pago Pago only. There will be no Nuku'alofa call on this voyage.
