Schedule changes on NZPAC and NOUVAPAC services

Dear Valued Customers,

We would like to advise of necessary changes to our NZPAC and NOUVAPAC services to accommodate operational requirements and vessel maintenance.

NZPAC - PFL MATAI Voyage 007

Subject vessel will load all cargo as scheduled in Tauranga and Auckland and proceed to Fiji. In Suva she will discharge all cargo destined to Samoa and Tonga. She will then call Lautoka arriving on August 4th, where she will discharge her remaining cargo and then perform maintenance until around August 12th, before loading export cargo and returning to Tauranga.

Cargo on the PFL Matai 007 for Samoa & Tonga will tranship at Suva onto the Capitaine Magellan Voyage 047 commencing in Fiji. We estimate that Samoa & Tonga destined cargo will arrive within one day of previously advertised scheduled of the PFL Matai 007.
